President Jason Combs called meeting to order at 5:45 p.m.

**Approval of Feb. 2023 meeting minutes.** Nathan made a motion to approve the Feb. minutes, Troy seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Sydney informed the Board that she was having a difficult time hiring enployees for the upcoming golf season. Sydney and Board talked about new strategies on getting people to apply for hire. Sydney said she will continue to advertise in the TF Voice, Facebook/Instagram and on the Web Site. An increase in the starting hourly wage with possibly increases as the season goes on. Sydney will have the latitude to determine what those increases might be. Sydney also informed the Board that Overland Golf Course in Big Timber would not be interested in participating this year in the reciprocal program.

Greens Committee – John gave the Greens Committee report. John and his crew are working on equipment getting ready for the new golf season. John said he is still looking for a used rough mower.

**Old Business** - The Board looked at the 332 survey responses concerning the Clubhouse expansion and simulator instillation. After great discussion, the Board decided to postpone the Clubhouse expansion. The biggest concerns were the rising costs, rising interest rates and the ability to staff the new facility. Jeff will reach out to 406 Contractors to inform them of the postponement.

**New Business-** Headwaters Golf Course will donate one single pass and one couples pass to the TF Education Foundation annual auction to be held on March 16th. The Board talked about the allocation of the \$7.00 fee per player for the high school golf tournament.
